Meeting in Huelva (Spain), 6th April 2022.

Partners of the SIAC project took part in a transnational project meeting at the **Inercia Digital** Training and Innovation Center located in Huelva, Spain.

"For us, it was very important to be able to meet again face to face, so we could discuss all the topics related to the implementation of the project and spend a pleasant time together, and get partners to know the city" stated María Fernández Reyes, project manager from Inercia Digital and main host of the event.

During the meeting, project partners focused on the progress of the first intellectual output, which involves the development of a course on cyberbullying, how to recognise, prevent and tackle it, with a focus on cyberbullying and LGBTQI+. Partners discussed the details for the development of a handbook, to contain all the modules developed by the partnership.

Also, partners discussed the second intellectual output, which will consist in an online course on cyberbullying through an online e-learning platform, which will be designed by Inercia Digital and the contents will be translated to offer the course in the different languages of the partnership.

Other issues discussed were the dissemination activities, which are very important to keep the public informed about the project activities.

Finally, the meeting ended with a visit to the monument of Christopher Columbus in Huelva and tasting some typical Spanish food.
