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Third Project Meeting in Bari (Italy)

Partners of the SIAC project will meet in Bari on 30th September to hold the third transnational project meeting. The meeting will be hosted by **Eurosud**, the partner organisation based in Southern Italy whose goal is to offer support, help, services and counselling in the areas of development of civil society and democratic institutions, civil values and non-formal education for all citizens, especially for young people from the local community.

During the one-day meeting, partners will take stock of the project, assess all the work done so far, making sure that all the activities have been implemented according to plan and all the deliverables produced are of the expected quality and have been properly promoted. It will also be an opportunity to plan the last few weeks of the project, in particular the multiplier events in each partner country and the final conference in the UK.

Piloting activities

Throughout the month of September, partners will be conducting a piloting of the SIAC e-course on 250 people from all the partner countries. The aim of the piloting will be to test the methodology/curriculum produced on the target group and gather feedback which will be used to make improvements where necessary.

Partners are actively recruiting participants to take part in the piloting. People interested will need to register to the online platform, complete the free online course (approx. 8 hours of instruction in self-learning format), and submit the evaluation feedback. People completing the course and passing the final test, will be awarded a CPD Certification.
